UL to launch Tax Clinic offering free tax support to unrepresented taxpayers

One-of-a-kind initiative will widen access to tax advice, compliance support and taxpayer education for people and small businesses unable to afford tax practitioners

The University of Limpopo (UL) invites members of the media to the official launch of the University of Limpopo Tax Clinic, an initiative established to provide free tax services to unrepresented taxpayers.

The Tax Clinic, an initiative of the University's School of Accountancy, and School of Law in the Faculty of Management and Law, seeks to close the gap faced by individuals and small businesses who cannot afford the services of professional tax practitioners.

Through the Clinic, members of the public will have access to free tax advice, tax compliance support and taxpayer education. The initiative will also help taxpayers better understand their rights and responsibilities when dealing with tax matters.

The launch will bring together international experts, academics, industry representatives, small businesses and tax professionals to discuss the role of tax clinics in advancing taxpayer rights, social justice and compliance. International guest speakers include Donovan Castelyn, an International Taxpayer Rights Advocate from Australia, and Annette Morgan, Director of the Curtin Tax Clinic in Australia. Representatives from SARS, the Office of the Tax Ombud, professional bodies, SA Tax Clinics and tax practitioners are also expected to participate.
